19 YEARS AFTER NITHARI KILLINGS

SC acquits Koli, orders his release

OBSERVING THAT “suspicion, however grave, cannot replace proof beyond reasonable doubt” and “courts cannot prefer expediency over legality,” the Supreme Court Tuesday set aside the conviction of Surendra Koli in a case of rape and murder of a teenage girl, one of the many cases that arose out of the Nithari serial killings two decades ago, and ordered his “forthwith” release.

The bench of Chief Justice of India B R Gavi and Justices Surya Kant and Vikram Nates reversed Koli's conviction while allowing his curative petition, and directed that he be released if not wanted in any other case.

The bench noted that Koli had already been acquitted in 12 of the 13 cases against him and wondered how the same set of evidence that did not hold good in the 12 cases could be relied upon for conviction in just one. “There was no credible chain of custody or expert testimony establishing that a domestic help with no medical training could perform the precise dismemberment described. These gaps were central to the acquittals in the twelve cases. They are equally present here,” the bench said.

It found procedural violations in the manner in which his Section 164 statement was recorded by the magistrate. It also pointed to loopholes in the recoveries allegedly made and said the forensic analysis only helped establish the identity of the victims and did not link the accused to the crime.

The Nithari killings came to light with the discovery of skeletal remains of eight children from a drain behind businessman Moninder Singh Pandher's house in Noida on December 29, 2006. Koli

worked at Pandher's house. Further digging around the house led to the recovery of more skeletal remains. Most of these remains were those of poor children and young women who had gone missing from the area.

Pandher and Koli, who were arrested the same month, were accused of abducting and raping children and women and disposing of their bodies in a drain. It was alleged that Koli killed the girls and chopped the bodies before throwing them away. There was even suspicion of cannibalism.

On October 16, 2023, the Allahabad High Court acquitted Koli in 12 cases and Pandher in two. Both had earlier been awarded the death penalty in these cases relating to rape, murder, and destruction of evidence, among others, by a special CBI court in Ghaziabad.

In July this year, the Supreme Court dismissed all appeals filed by CBI, and the families of the victims challenged the acquittals. Koli, however, continued to remain in prison, as he was convicted in one of the cases and was sentenced to life imprisonment by the High Court.

A special CBI court convicted both Koli and Pandher in the case, which was related to

the death of a 14-year-old girl. On appeal, the Allahabad High Court acquitted Pandher but upheld Koli's conviction and confirmed his death sentence.

Following this, Koli moved the Supreme Court with a plea, which was dismissed in 2011, and his review petition against this was also dismissed by the apex court in 2014.

In January 2015, the Allahabad High Court commuted Koli's sentence to life imprisonment in this case, citing “inordinate delay in the disposal of the mercy petition”.

On Tuesday, acquitting Koli in the 13th case, the Supreme Court said, “...It is a matter of deep regret that despite prolonged investigation, the identity of the actual perpetrator has not been established in a manner that meets the legal standards. Criminal law does not permit conviction on conjecture or on a hunch. Suspicion, however grave, cannot replace proof beyond reasonable doubt. Courts cannot prefer expediency over legality. The presumption of innocence endures until guilt is proved through admissible and reliable evidence, and when the proof fails the only lawful outcome is to set aside the conviction even in a case involving horrific crimes.”

THE HOUSE of horrors in Nithari now stands alone, dilapidated and covered with overgrown shrubs on a street, which also houses rows of luxury villas. To those who have settled in the area after the 2006 Nithari killings caught the nation's attention, the house is now “haunted by the ghosts of those who were allegedly killed inside it”.

On Tuesday, the Supreme Court set aside the conviction of Surendra Koli in a case of rape and murder of a teenage girl — one of many such cases, known as the Nithari serial killings.

The killings came to light after the skeletal remains of eight children were found in a drain behind businessman Moninder Singh Pandher's house at Noida's Nithari on December 29, 2006. Koli was the help at Pandher's house then.

For the girl's father and mother, now 63 and 60, respectively, the justice system has “routinely failed” them. “We kept telling the police that something

strange was going on in that house and they would tell us that we were imagining things,” said the mother. They are among the kin of the victims, who stayed back. The rest, they said, have returned to their hometowns.

The couple run a small ironing business from a shack. It is not far from the house owned by Pandher. Sunita recalled frequently receiving clothes from the house allegedly with stains. “I would ask him (Koli) about the stains and he would simply respond that sahab [master] had stood too close to the butcher when he had gone to buy chicken,” the mother said.

Their daughter had gone to a tailor behind Pandher's house on an evening in 2006, but never returned. “She was good at studies. She wanted to be a doctor,” the mother said.

Asked about the SC verdict, the parents seemed more tired than angry. “I want the policemen who let them get out to suffer,” said the woman. “If Pandher is not guilty, Koli is not guilty, then who is? If the policemen are responsible (for the

acquittal) then they are the ones who should be hanged,” the father said. “They were let out of jail because the children who were killed were poor.”

The mother said the case fell through despite the police having the evidence. “I saw the bodies being exhumed from the drain. Who put them there? The police found stacks of ID cards belonging to labourers and school children. Why were those there? Why did the police find my child's clothes inside the house? How can the courts declare them innocent?”

The couple, however, said that they have resigned to their fate. “We had to sell our house to pay the lawyers. We now live in a jhuggi on rent. We can't fight anymore...,” said the father.

For them, moving out of Nithari is out of the question. “We have built our lives here... Our children have settled here,” the father said. “She would have had her own family by now... I miss her the most when I serve food to my five children. I always tend to forget that one has left us...,” the mother went on.

two men as Praveen Kumar, a resident of Hapur district, and Satendra Singh, who hails from Bighrao village, Bulandshahr. The police said that the accused had used forged Aadhaar cards, PAN cards, rental agreements, to fraudulently register multiple businesses on the Udyam portal for MSME. ENS

MHT-CET to follow JEE Main model, to be held twice — in April and May

Mumbai, November 11

IN AN important development for Class 12 students across Maharashtra, the MHT-CET will now be conducted twice, on the lines of the Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) Main. For admission to the academic year 2026-27, there will be two sessions of MHT-CET – one in April and another in May. Appearing for one entrance exam will be mandatory for admissions, while appearing for both attempts will be optional. In case of two attempts, the best of the two scores will be considered for admission, as per the practice followed by JEE Main, the na-

tional-level entrance test for engineering and technology admissions. Maharashtra's Higher and Technical Education Minister Chandrakant Patil made the announcement on Tuesday, following a review meeting with the state Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell, which conducts entrance tests for admission to various higher education courses in Maharashtra. "At the national level, two JEE entrance examinations are conducted, giving students two opportunities. Similarly, students in Maharashtra will also get two opportunities through these two entrance exams," said Patil. The MHT-CET is a state-

wide entrance test for admission to professional courses such as engineering, pharmacy, agriculture, architecture, etc. It is generally held in April with one session each for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM) and Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB) groups of subjects. From the upcoming admission cycle, there will be two sessions per subject group. An official from the higher education department said, "The new system is to allow students a choice to appear for MHT-CET as per their convenience. Apart from allowing a

chance for aspirants to up their scores, a CET held twice will also allow students another chance should they miss the first one for any reason. In the existing system of one attempt, if a candidate missed it due to any reason, there was no such chance." Along with MHT-CET, the plan includes two attempts for MBA/MMS CET too, which determines admission to popular postgraduate courses of the management stream. This CET is generally held in April and will now be held twice – once in April and another session in May, just like MHT-CET.



Fire breaks out in storeroom of Thane court building, none injured: Police

Thane: A fire broke out in the storeroom of the extended building of the Thane district and sessions court on Tuesday morning, but no injuries were reported in the blaze.

The incident was reported to the Thane Municipal Corporation's (TMC) Disaster Management Cell (DMC) at 11:19 am, following which immediate response teams were dispatched to the site at Court Naka in

Thane (West), a civic official said. According to information received from the Jawaharbagh Fire Station, the blaze, suspected to have resulted from an electrical short circuit, originated in the storeroom on the first floor of the two-storey extended court building.

Preliminary reports indicated old documents and electrical wiring in the room caught fire. PTI

Cops foil cattle smuggling bid: 52 buffaloes rescued, 3 arrested

Nanded: Police on Tuesday rescued 52 buffaloes after intercepting a container truck and arrested three individuals for alleged illegal smuggling of cattle in Nanded district of Maharashtra, officials said.

Police discovered that buffaloes were crammed tightly inside the truck and tied with ropes in an extremely cruel manner, causing distress
